WHAT: We host groups from schools, organizations and companies throughout the Denver metro area to sort used books. The used books are sorted for the biannual Used Book Sales, the Red Chair Bookshop or online sales. Proceeds from the sale of used books benefit the programs and services of Denver Public Library.

WHEN: Book-sorting shifts are available on most Mondays and Fridays throughout the year. Volunteer groups are asked to commit to a three-hour shift in the morning (9:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m.) or afternoon (1:00 p.m.–4:00 p.m.). **Volunteer shifts must be scheduled with Andrea Hamilton in advance.**

WHERE: Book sorting happens in the basement level of Central Library, located downtown at 10 W 14th Ave Pkwy, Denver, CO 80204.

WHO: Groups of volunteers of up to 10 individuals are welcome.

NOTE: Book sorting is dusty, physical work. Please wear comfortable closed-toe shoes and clothing that can get dirty. Aprons will be provided.
